Two decades ago, quite by accident, my attention was drawn to the existence of material for the most part unrecorded on either side of the Atlantic; after brief inquiry, I was surprised to find myself in possession of matter which I thought as interesting as it was novel. If the presentation shows an idyllic tinge, enthusiasm must be my excuse; indeed, admitting a basis of primitive barbarism, the songs belong to a period in which the crude ore had been so successfully refined that, even from a literary point of view, some of the rhymes will continue to be esteemed as a treasure of the language. Eleven years later, the abundant and admirable gathering of Mrs. Gomme furnished means for comparison; it then appeared that between British and American usages of play existed a correspondence approaching identity.
